1. Summons of Court can be served by?

**Ans.-**Police officer, an officer of court, public servant

2. Under code of criminal procedure substituted service of summons can be made?

**Ans.-**By affixing summons on the house

3. Under section 97 of the code of criminal procedure search warrant to find out a person can be issued if ?

**Ans.-**The person is unlawfully confined

4. Under section 107 of the code of criminal procedure, Executive Magistrate can obtain bond from a person if?

**Ans.-** The person is likely to commit a breach of peace

5. A divorced wife is entitled to maintenance from her husband?

**Ans.-** Till she re-marries

6. Executive Magistrate can put a party in possession of immovable property?

**Ans.-** Upon the police report that a dispute in respect of such property is likely to disturb public peace

7. In a private complaint case process can be issued against an accused after?

**Ans.-** The magistrate is of the opinion that there is sufficient ground to proceed with the case

8. Any defect in charge

**Ans.-** Can be cured by amending it with a direction to retrial if such amendment is causing prejudice to the accused

9. Statement of an accused is recorded

**Ans.-** To enable him to explain circumstances appearing in the evidence against him.

10. The court on application for plea bargaining by the accused, to satisfy itself that is is made voluntarily

**Ans.-** Examines him in camera

11. Decree means.

**Ans.-** Formal expression of the court of an adjudication determining the rights of parties

12. 'Judgment' Means

**Ans.-** Statement of the Judges on the grounds of decree or order

13. If objection to the jurisdiction of the court is taken at the hearing of any application for interim relief the court shall proceed to?

**Ans.-** To determine issue as to the jurisdiction

14. Res-judicata means.?

**Ans.-** Not trying the suit if suit involving similar issues between similar parties is decided

15. Objection to the territorial jurisdiction of a Court can be allowed if it is raised

**Ans.-** At the earliest possible opportunity and before issues are settled

16. In case of a decree for the payment of money, the court can order interest at the rate of

**Ans.-** 6% P.A.

17. Under the inherent powers of the Civil Court, it can pass orders

**Ans.-** Necessary for the ends of justice or to prevent abuse of the process of the Court

18. Defendant can claim temporary injunction in a suit filed by the plaintiff

**Ans.-** To prevent the suit property being alienated or damaged

**Ans.-** 30 days

20. Where any period is fixed or granted by the court for doing an act prescribed by the code of Civil Procedure, the court may enlarge such period

**Ans.-** Not exceeding 30 days in total

**Ans.-** That the document is duly executed

22. A document can be proved

**Ans.-** By examining the person in whose hand writing the document is written or signed

23. A confessional statement made before police

**Ans.-** Is admissible only if it relates to a fact discovered in consequence of it

**Ans.-** Not a conclusive proof but operates only as estoppel

25. Admission means.

**Ans.-** Statement suggesting inference as to any fact in issue
