CASES ON SEC. 302 OF I.P.C.

(B) Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 300 – Murder – Defective investigation – Held, by itself cannot be made a ground for acquitting accused. (Allarakha K. Mansuri V. State of Gujarat, 2002 (3) Mah.L.R. 296).

Penal Code (1860), Ss.300, 324 – Murder or culpable homicide not amounting to murder – Blow on chest of deceased with sharp cutting weapon – When victim was trying to escape accused catching hold of her hair and throwing her on ground and then inflicting more blows – Injuries grievous in nature and dangerous to life – Held intention was at least to cause such bodily injury as was likely to cause death and hence accused was rightly convicted under S.302. (Karu Marik V. State of Bihar, 2001 ALL M
