

**CASES ON SEC. 302 OF I.P.C.**

(B) Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 300 – Murder – Defective investigation – Held, by itself cannot be made a ground for acquitting accused. (**Allarakha K. Mansuri V. State of Gujarat, 2002 (3) Mah.L.R. 296**).

Penal Code (1860), Ss.300, 324 – Murder or culpable homicide not amounting to murder – Blow on chest of deceased with sharp cutting weapon – When victim was trying to escape accused catching hold of her hair and throwing her on ground and then inflicting more blows – Injuries grievous in nature and dangerous to life – Held intention was at least to cause such bodily injury as was likely to cause death and hence accused was rightly convicted under S.302. (**Karu Marik V. State of Bihar, 2001 ALL M**
